

2022 PLAYER POINTS SYSTEM

Administration

Rugby League Ipswich will act as the Player Points System Administrator. Player Points will be assigned prior to week one of the competition and sent to the respective clubs for their information.

All players that are classed as Re – Registrations from 2022 will be assigned the points minus a years' service. All new players to the club will be assigned points from the 2021 Player Points Index.

The formulation of a Player Points Sub Committee will be created to assign players with a value at the commencement of each season. The Sub Committee will comprise of 2 of the following 3 members. These members will consist of the local QRL staff, NRL Development Officer and a RLI Board member. This Value will remain the same for the WHOLE season.

Team Points Allocation

a) **100 Points** are allocated to each team per "A" Grade game,

Player Points Allocation

- 1) Each Player will be allocated a Category based on the Highest Level they have played within the last 5 years. Player must play a minimum of 5 games in a season to be classified in a category.
- 2) If a club develops a player to a HIGHER BASE level they will remain at the Level they were at when they entered the club for this year.
- 3) Each club can nominate Two MARQUEE PLAYERS that will be exempt from the Player Points Index and will have a value of Zero (0). These players cannot be a transfer from an RLI Club. (If serious injury occurs the club has the right to apply in writing to RLI for another player to be classed as their MARQUEE PLAYER until initial player returns to the field)

Concessions / Discounts

- 1) Two points per year discount for each year service with that club. (Ipswich Jets Dual Registration not included)
- 2) If a "local junior" achieves a higher Category and returns to their local senior club they will return on the points they left with or be assigned points from Category H.

Definition

A 'Local Junior' is classified as a player being with a RLI Junior Club

- (a) More than three (3) consecutive years
- (b) There is the ability for one player to be classed as a junior of more than one club if more than 3 consecutive years is established at both clubs.

B	QCUP or Equivalent Competitions	20 points
C	Queensland Rangers	15 points
D	Division or State League Championship (Open Age) e.g. Ipswich Diggers	12 points
E	Inter Club A Grade Transfers	10 points
F	Inter Club Transfer (MM/Diggers Colts)/ Player with no History/ Jets Dual Registration	6 points
G	Equivalent A Grade Player / Hastings Deering Cup Colts	4 points
H	First Year of Senior Football / Non A Grade Player	2 points
